Mayor Fischer called the meeting to order.

Branson Building – Fischer reported George Elliott advised the cost for making some repairs to the front roof overhang (over the sidewalk on 4<sup>th</sup> Street) will be under \$1,000.

#### Appointment of Interim City Superintendent

Mayor Fischer appointed Donnie Allison to fill the position after receiving the resignation of City Superintendent Kevin Frogley earlier this week effective July 4, 2011. Fischer advised he had Clerk Peine advertise the position with the League of Kansas Municipalities, the city's website, and with Oswego, Parsons and Joplin papers. Rea made a motion and Brown seconded to approve the appointment. Motion carried.

Peine advised that Randy Snider with Rural Development, Iola would like to request the city hold a special meeting next week in order for them to present the Letter of Conditions on the City Hall, PD & FD project. Peine inquired if it would be possible to get a quorum. Thursday evening was the only night 3 of the attending councilmembers could attend, and Mayor Fischer can also be there. She will check with other members on Friday and advise everyone if a quorum will be available.

The group left to complete the tour of city properties. Upon return, Rea made a motion and Brown seconded to adjourn the meeting at 9:00 p.m.
